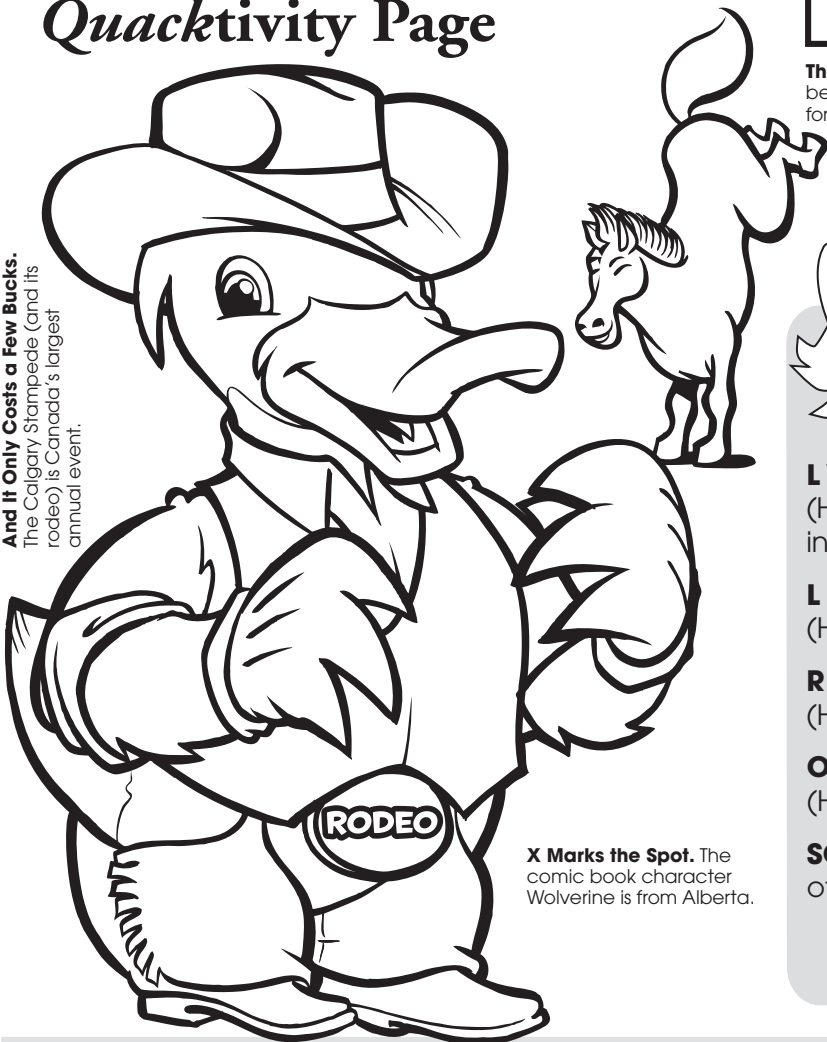
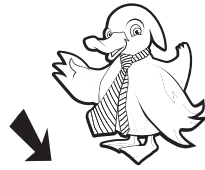

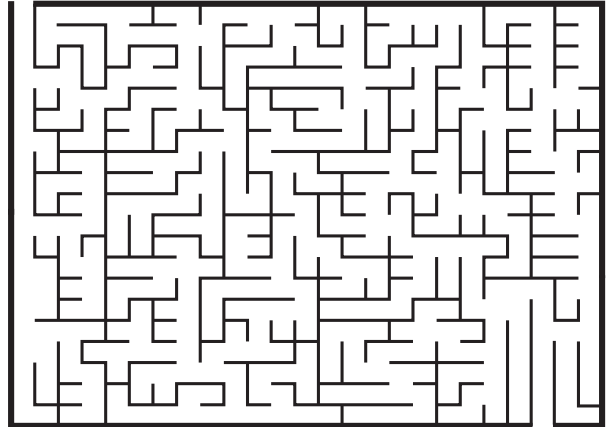
And it Only Costs a Few Bucks. The Calgary Stampede (and its rodeo) is Canada's largest annual event.
