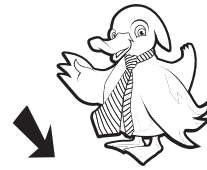
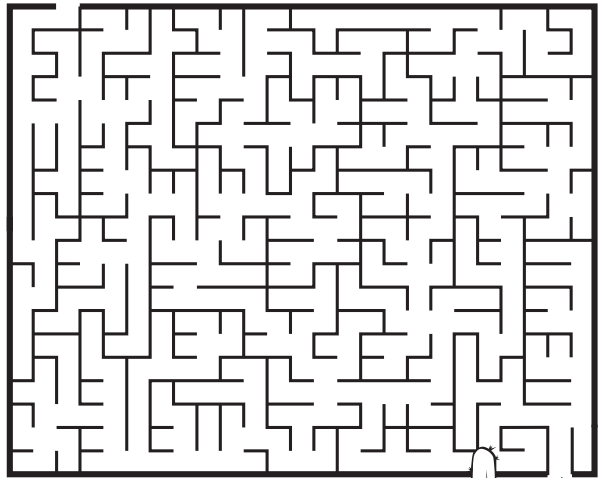

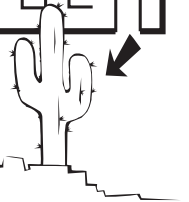

And You Thought It Was Falling Down, Falling Down. The original London Bridge was shipped stone-by-stone and reconstructed in Lake Havasu City.

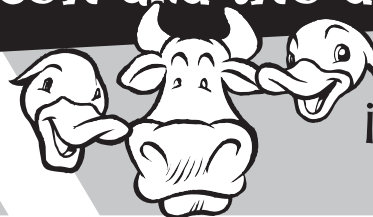
