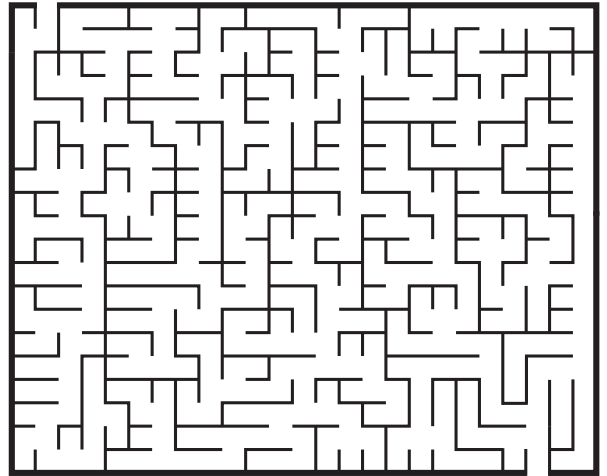
Pulp Nonfiction. Florida has more orange groves than anywhere else on Earth, producing 75 percent of all oranges grown in the U.S.



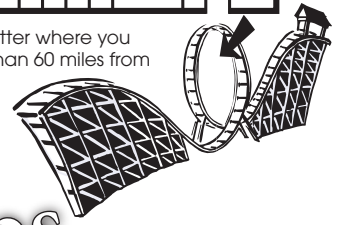
