For his top bill, add two broken curves to your circles:



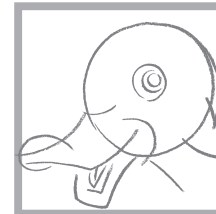
Add Lewis' bottom bill. One line is a check mark!
