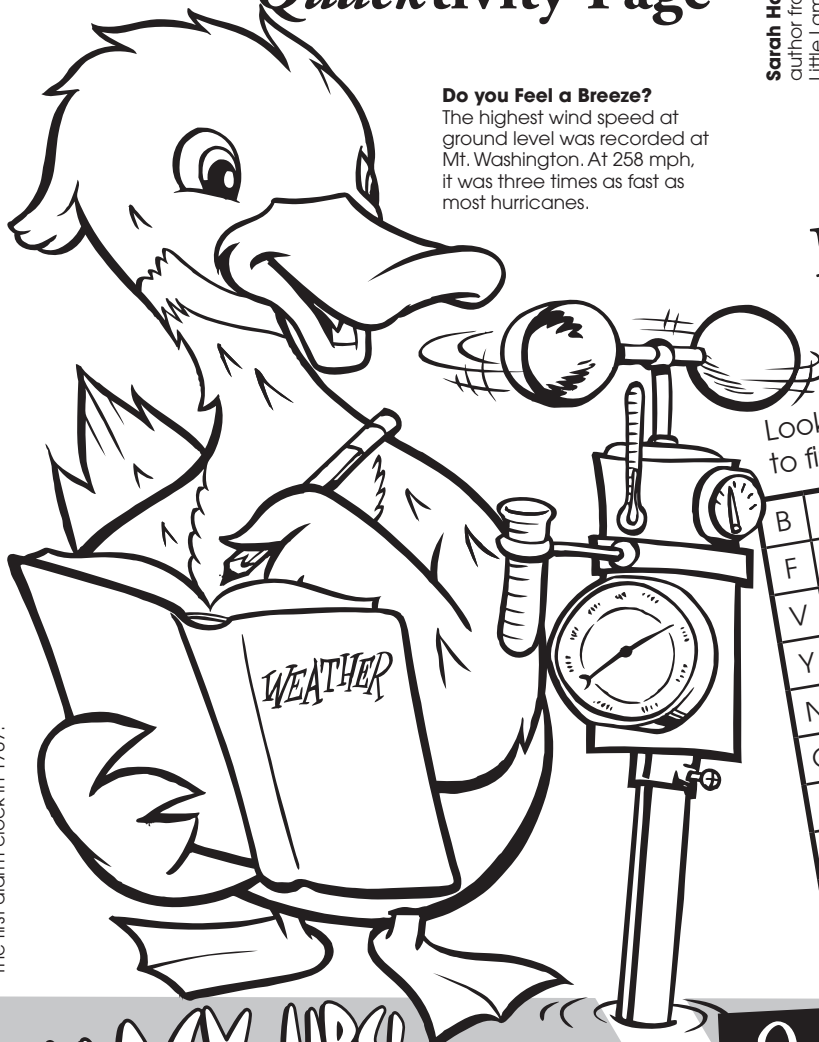

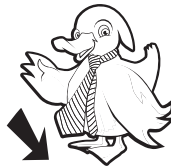

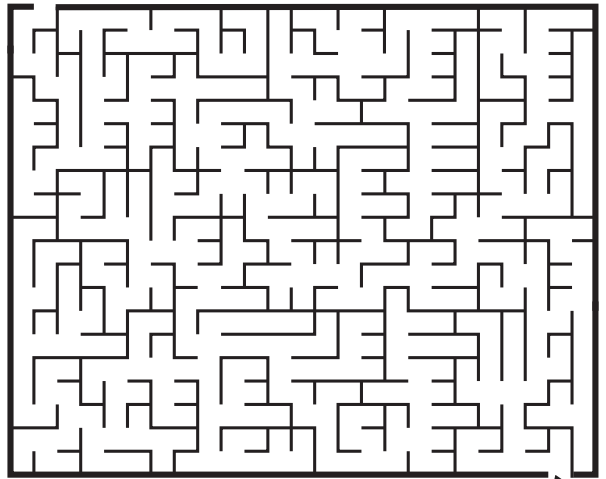


Do you Feel a Breeze?
