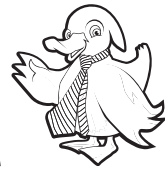


# Lewis The Duck in Colorado Quacktivity Page

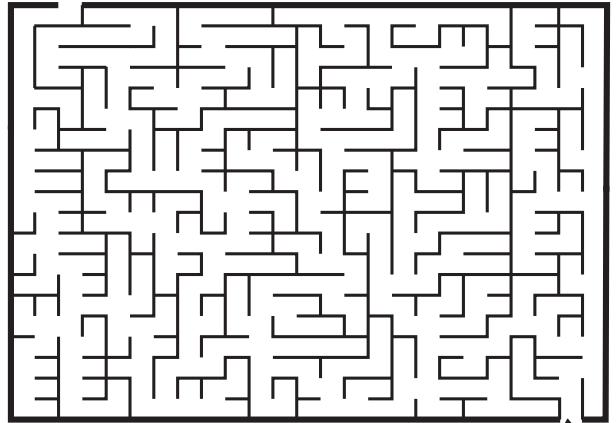
Hang On! The world's first rodeo was held on July 4th, 1869 in Deer Trail.

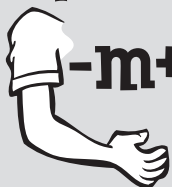
