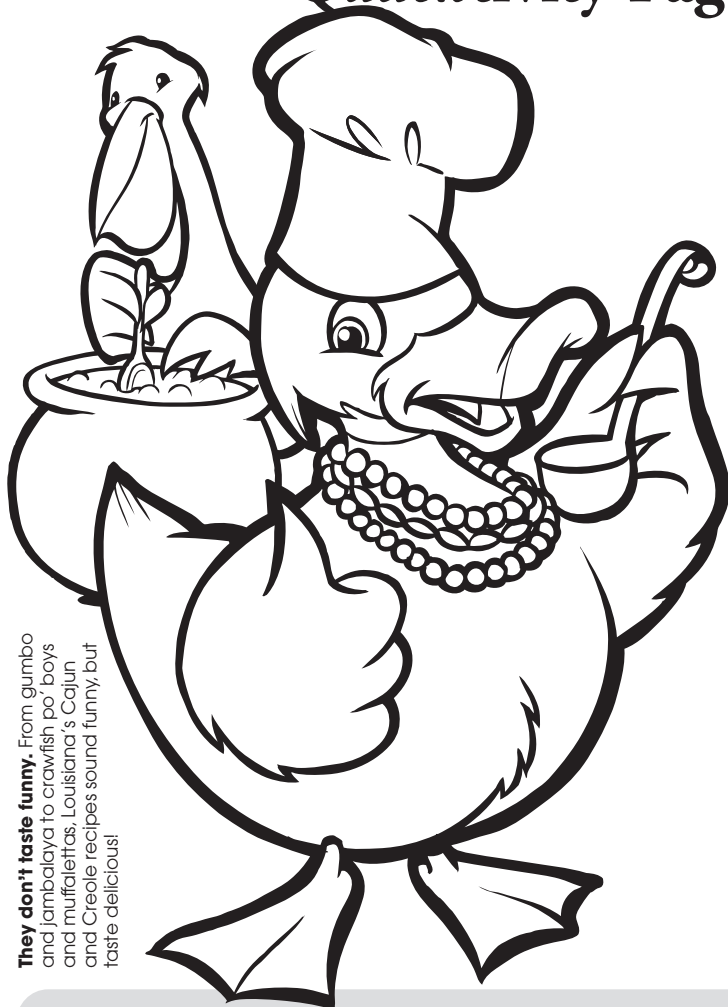


# Lewis The Duck in Louisiana Quacktivity Page

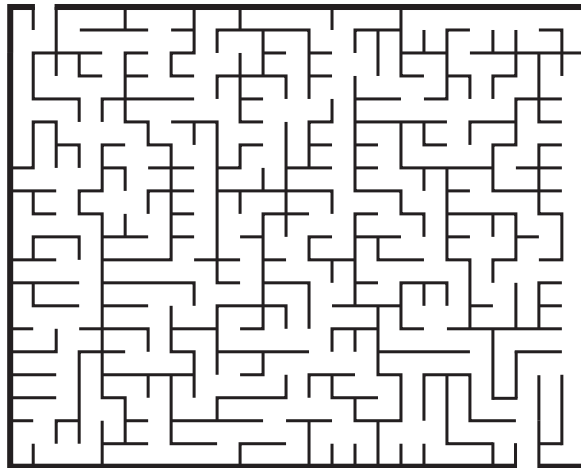

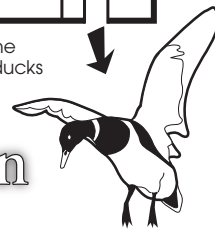
