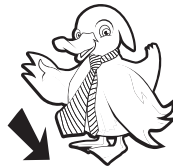

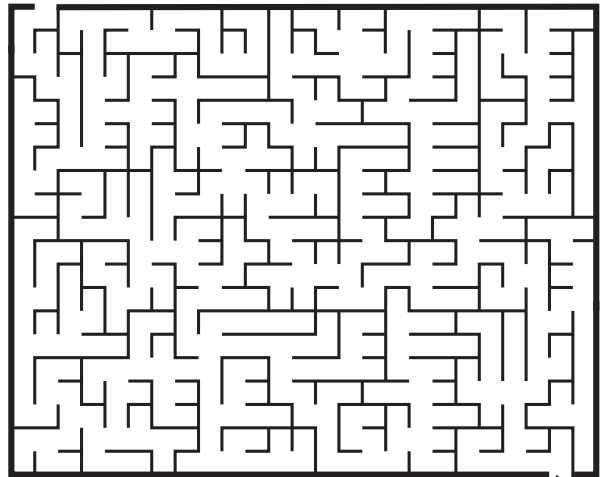

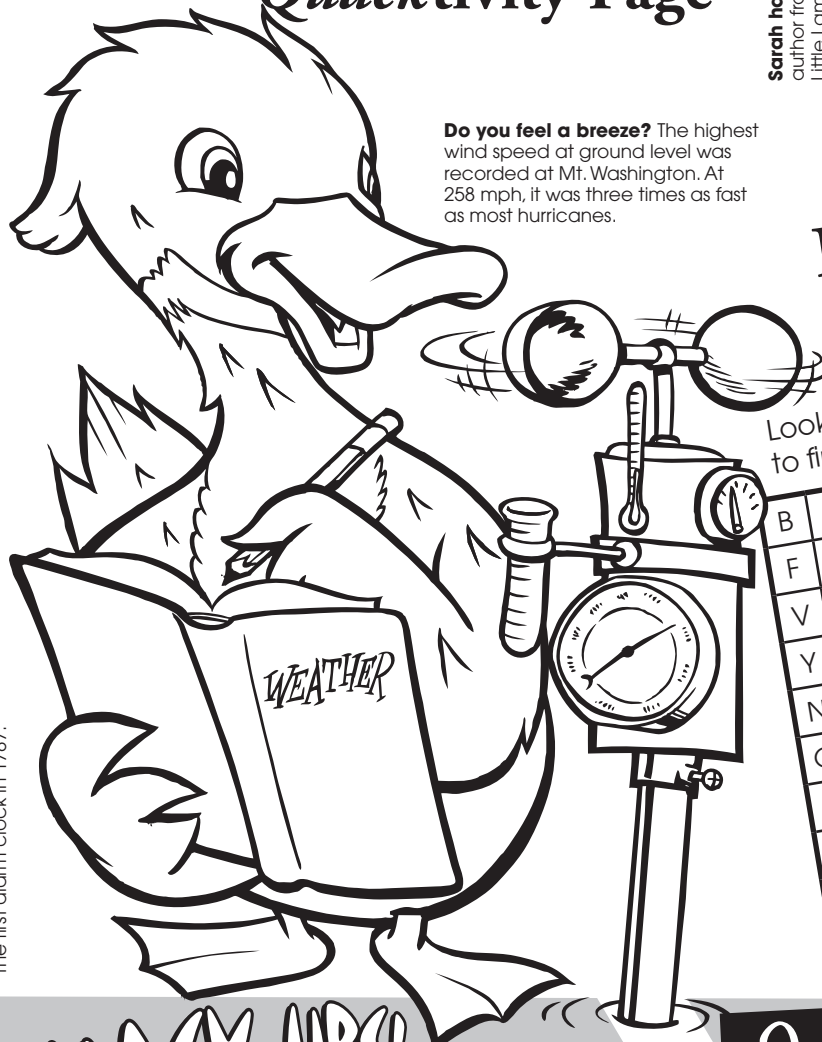


Help Lewis find his way to the library!
