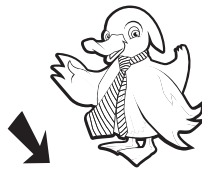
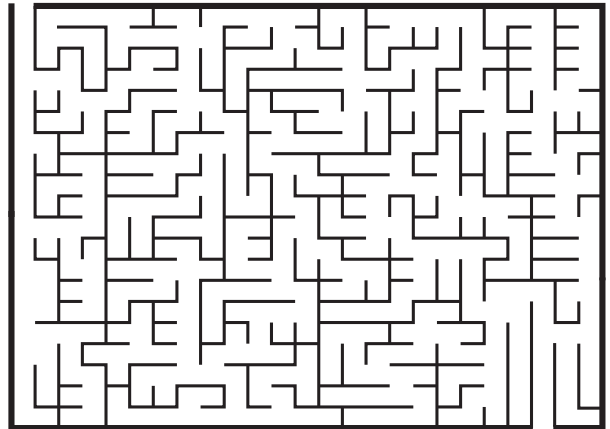

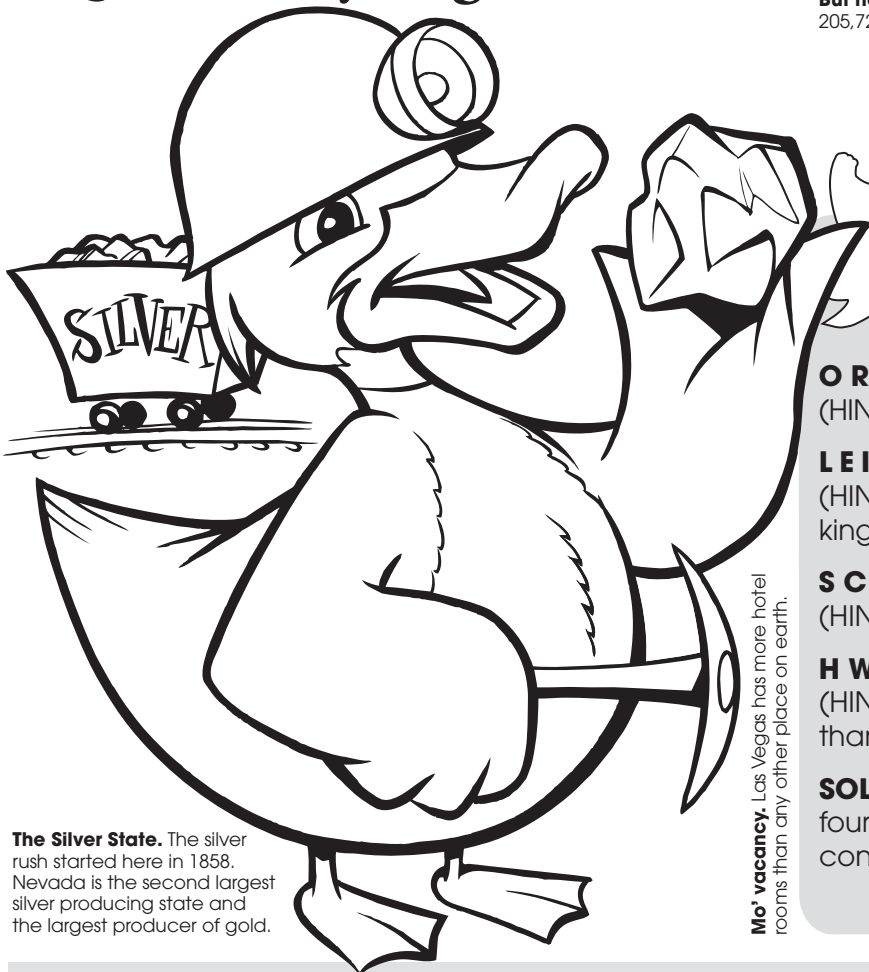


Help Lewis find his way to Las Vegas!
