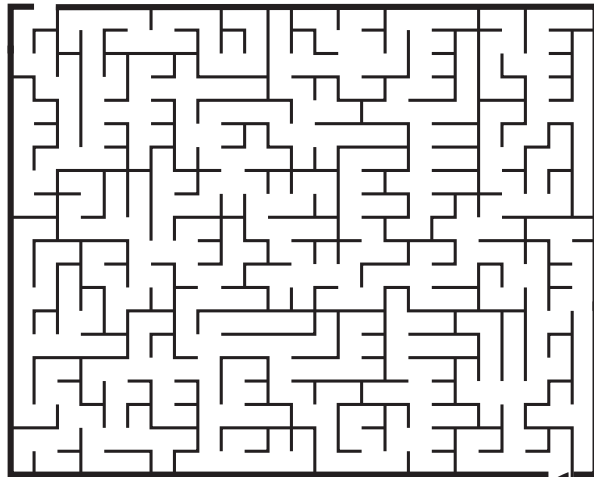


# Lewis The Duck in Wyoming Quacktivity Page

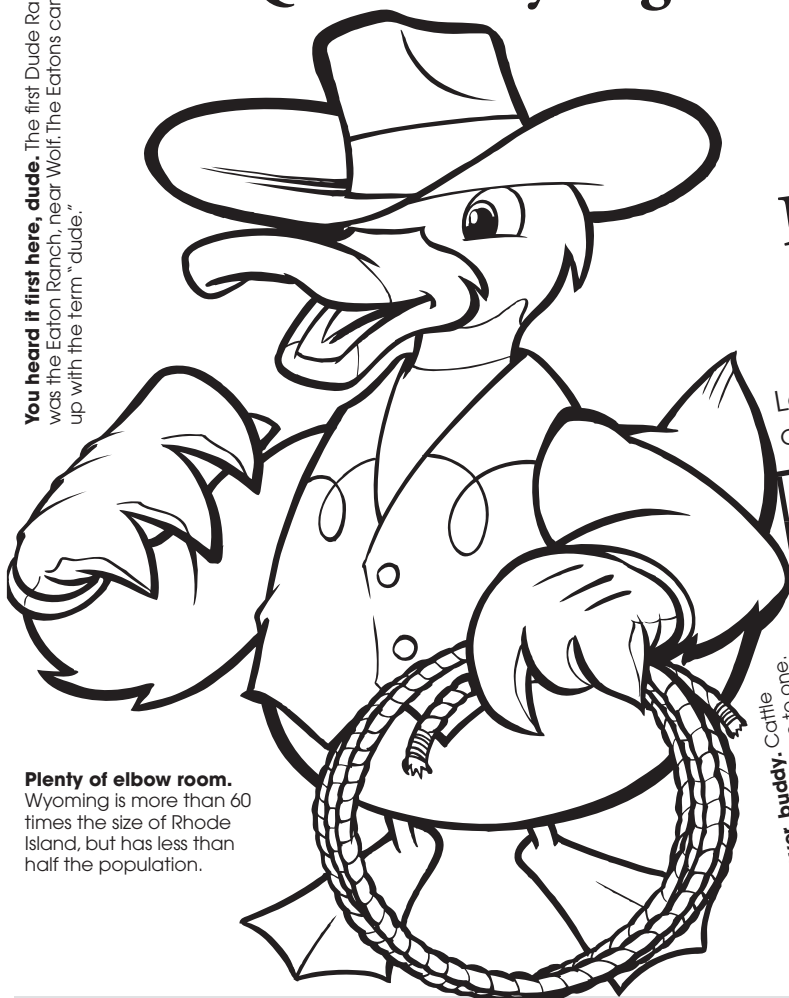
