Know Your 3 P's. Georgia produces more peaches, peanuts and pecans than any other state.

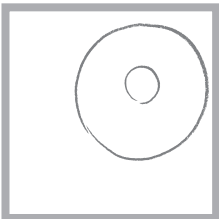


That's Gold in Them Hills! Auraria, near the city of Dahlonega, was the site of America's first Gold Rush in 1828.

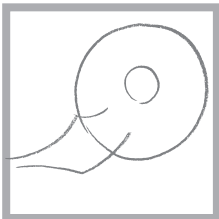
How to Draw Lewis

Follow along with the pictures below to complete your own Lewis drawing!

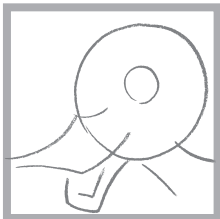
Draw two circles VERY lightly in pencil! Eraser ready!



For his top bill, add two broken curves to your circles:



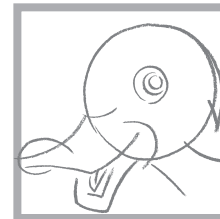
Add Lewis' bottom bill. One line is a check mark!



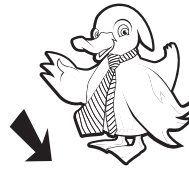
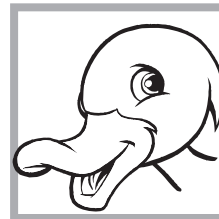
Add curves for the front and back of his eye, tongue and his neck.



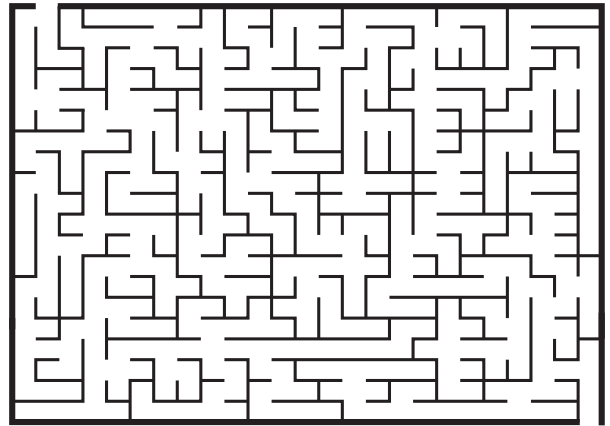
Now, Lewis gets his eye, tongue and the feather on his head.
