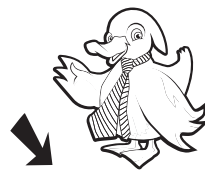
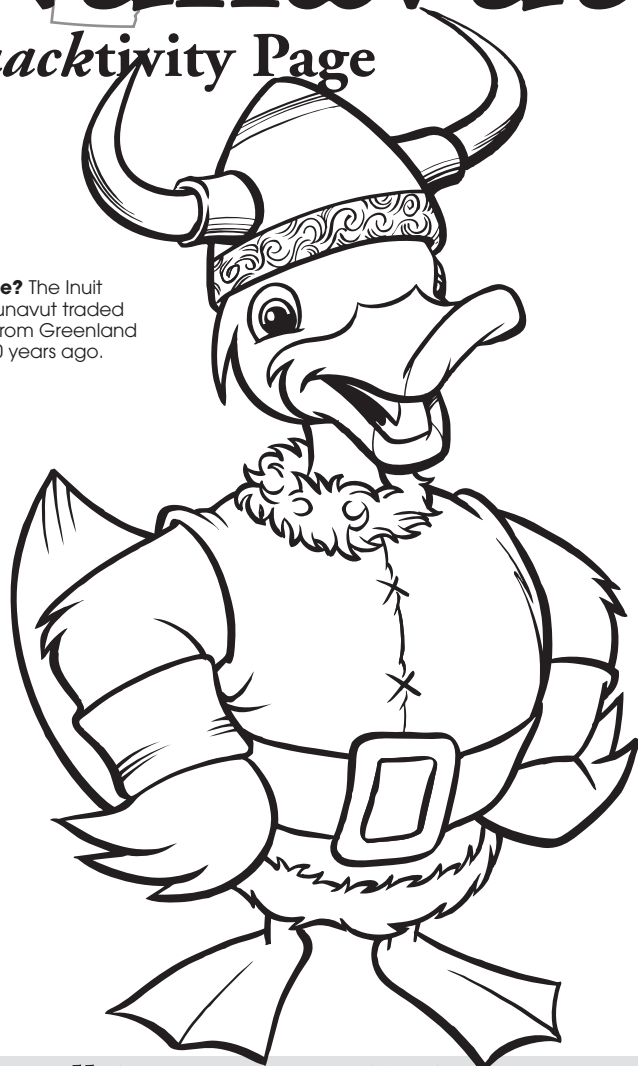


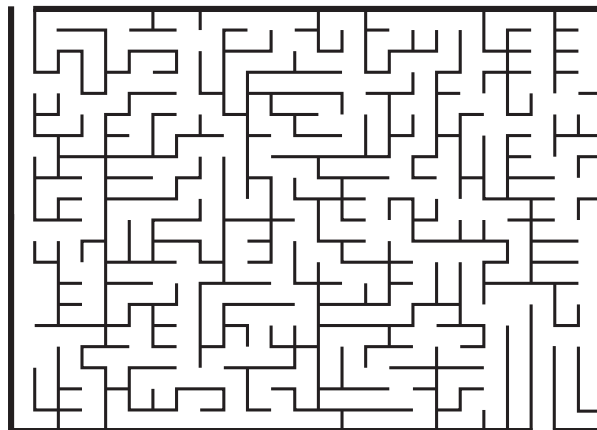

Help Lewis find his way to the plane to Nunavut!



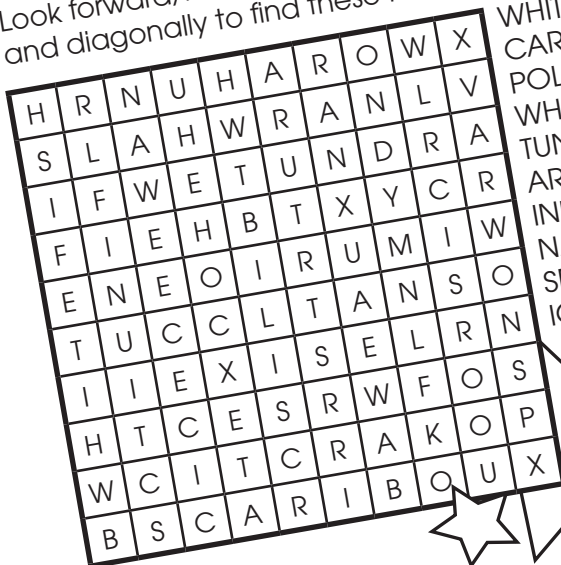
