Draw two circles VERY lightly in pencil! Eraser ready!

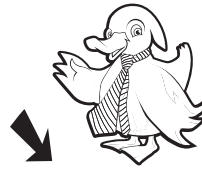
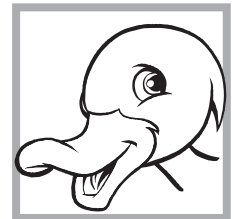
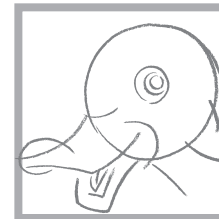
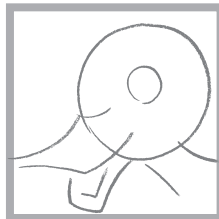
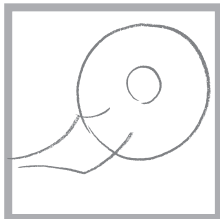
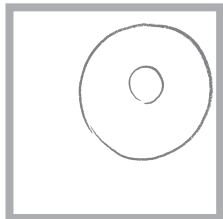
For his top bill, add two broken curves to your circles:

Add Lewis' bottom bill. One line is a check mark!

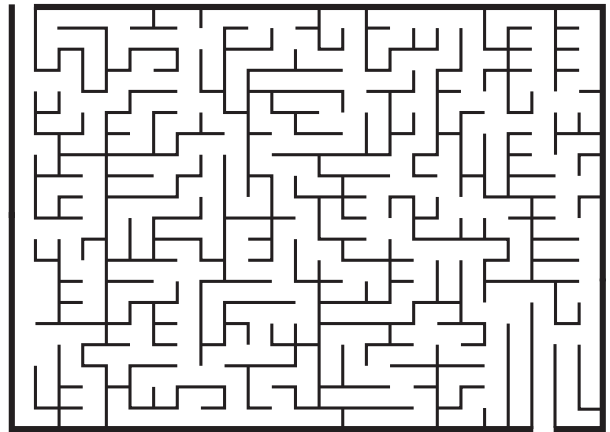
Add curves for the front and back of his bill and his neck.
