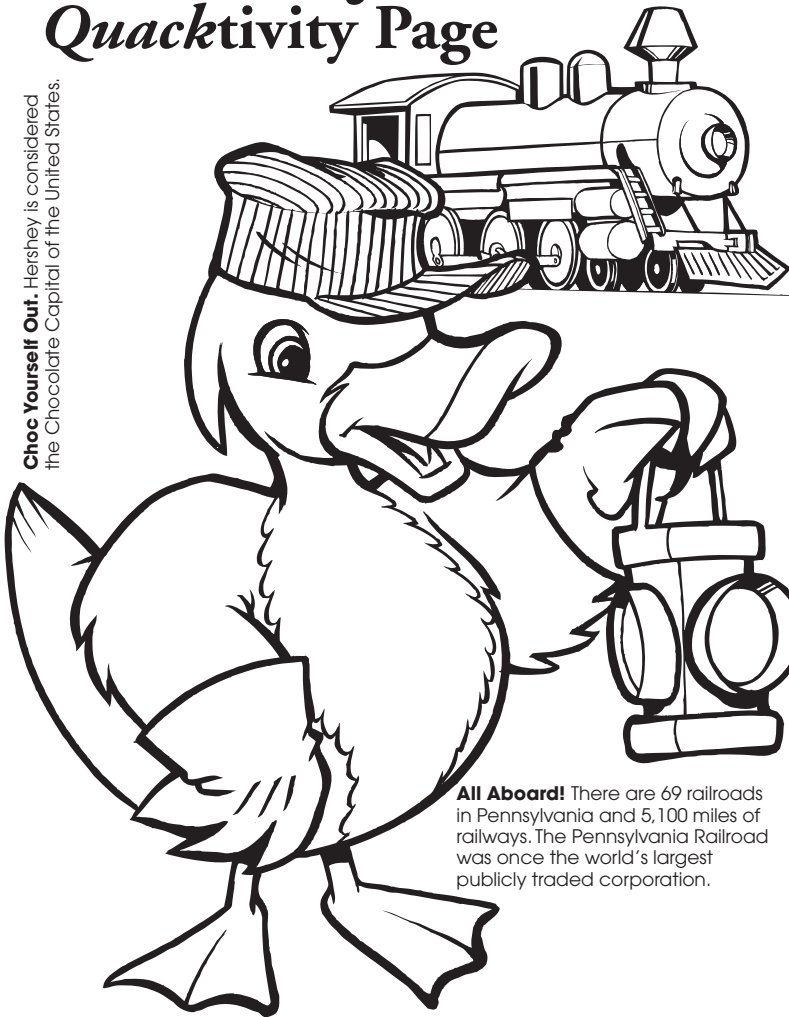

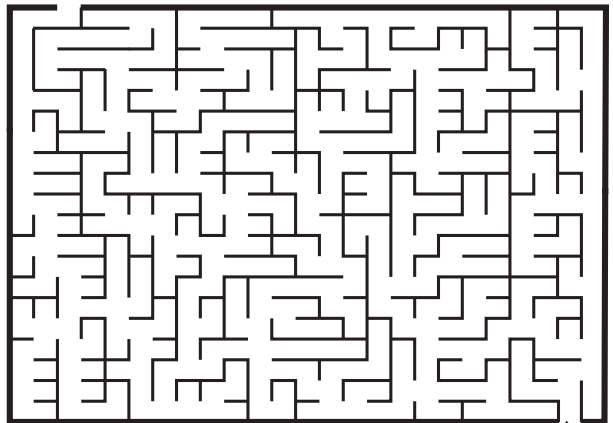
Choc Yourself Out. Hershey is considered the Chocolate Capital of the United States.



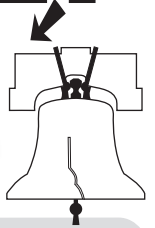
